

Predstavitev strategije za manj izgub in odpadne hrane

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Izveček

V skladu s sklepi Sveta EU iz 2016 in 2018 k zavezanosti doseganja trajnostnih razvojnih ciljev (SDG) Organizacije Združenih narodov, ki ima za enega od ciljev tudi prepolovitev odpadne hrane na prebivalca na maloprodajni in potrošniški ravni ter zmanjšanje izgub hrane vzdolž proizvodne in dobavne verige (Sustainable Development Goals 12.3) v okviru Agende za trajnostni razvoj do leta 2030, naj bi države članice Evropske Unije to dosegale preko nacionalnih strategij, zakonodaje in prostovoljnih ukrepov ter vpeljave upoštevanja hierarhije preprečevanja nastajanja odpadne hrane. Zato je Ministrstvo za kmetijstvo, gozdarstvo in prehrano leta 2019 pristopilo k pripravi Strategije za manj izgub in odpadne hrane v verigi preskrbe s hrano. Strategija je namenjena vsem členom verige preskrbe s hrano. Poleg splošnega pregleda stanja v Evropski uniji kot tudi v Sloveniji opredeljuje definicije odpadne hrane in izgub hrane kot tudi donirano hrano oz. viške hrane ter povezavo z varno hrano, ki lahko bistveno pripomore k manj odpadne hrane. Opredeljuje tudi sistem spremljanja odpadne hrane v Sloveniji. Kot osrednji del strategije je poglavje identificiranih točk nastajanja odpadne hrane in njenih vzrokov vsakega posameznega člena verige preskrbe s hrano. Iz SWOT analize sledi identifikacija potreb in strateški cilji ter operativni cilji, ki so konkretizirani preko potrebnih aktivnosti.

Title

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Abstract

In accordance with the EU Council conclusions of 2016 and 2018 on the commitment to achieve the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which also aims to halve food waste per capita at retail and consumer levels and reduce food losses along the production and supply chain (Sustainable Development Goals 12.3) under the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, the Member States of the European Union should achieve this through national strategies, legislation and voluntary measures, and the introduction of compliance with the food waste prevention hierarchy. Therefore, the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Food in 2019 started preparing a Strategy for less food losses and waste in the food supply chain. The strategy is aimed at all members of the food supply chain. It contains general overview about food losses and waste in the European Union as well as in Slovenia, it also defines the definitions of food waste and food losses as well as donated food or surplus food and the link to food safety, which can make a significant contribution to less food waste. It also defines the food waste monitoring system in Slovenia. As a central part of the strategy, there are identified points of food waste generation and its causes in each individual link in the whole food supply chain. Following the SWOT analysis, the identification of needs and strategic goals are written, as well as operational goals, which are concretized through the necessary activities.
